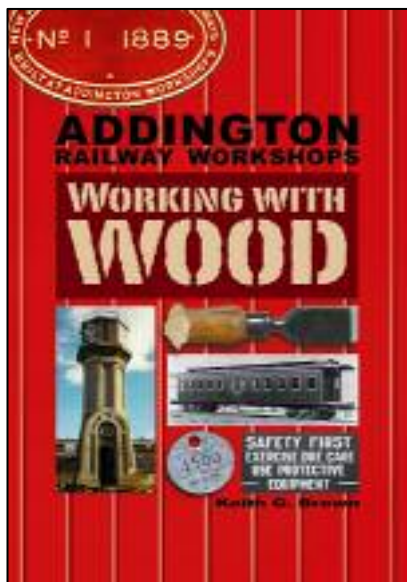

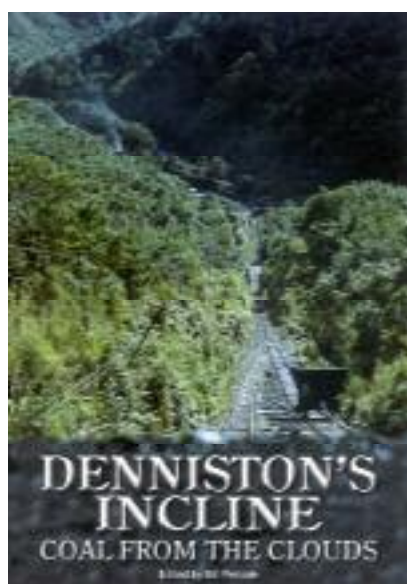


Addington Railway Workshops Working With Wood

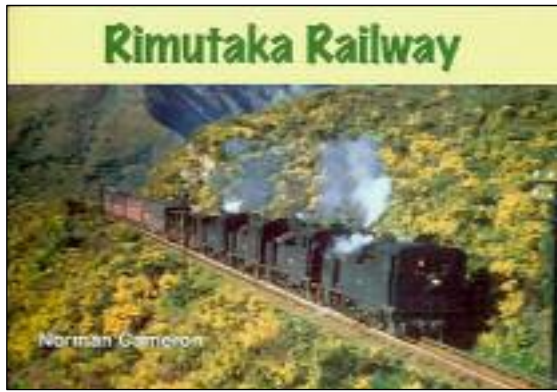


North Island Branch Lines

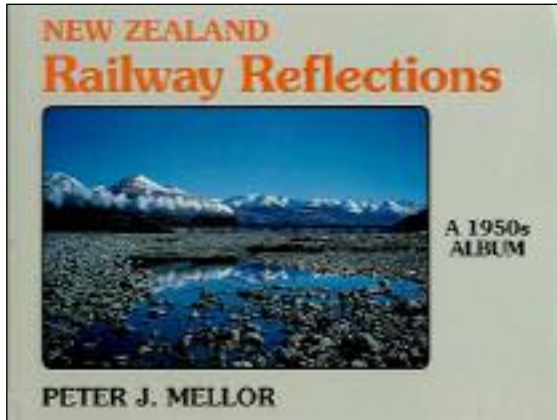


Rimutaka Railway

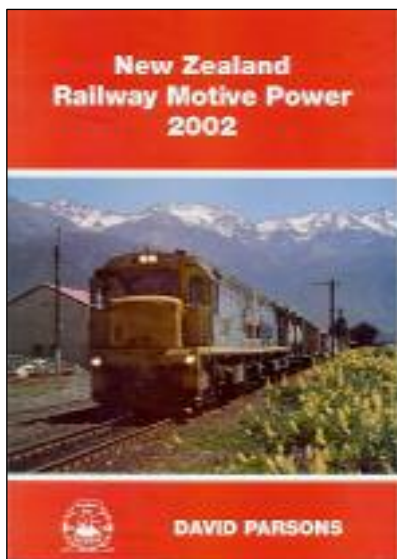


New Zealand Railway Reflections

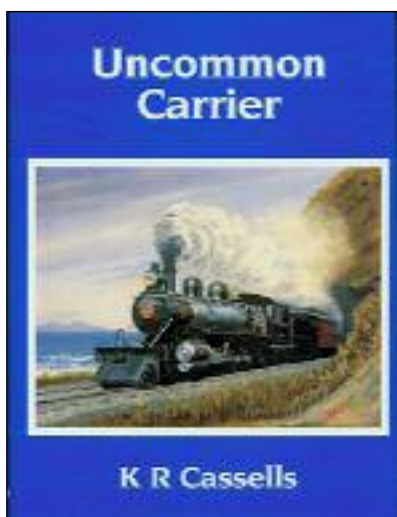


New Zealand Railway Motive Power

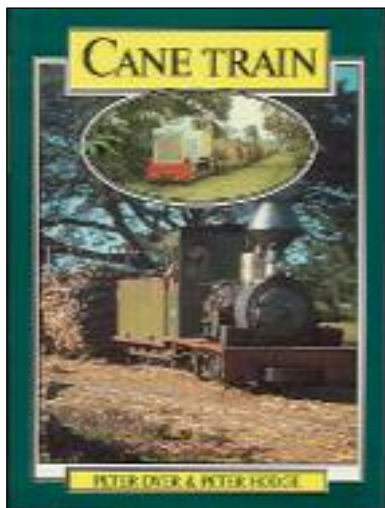


Uncommon Carrier

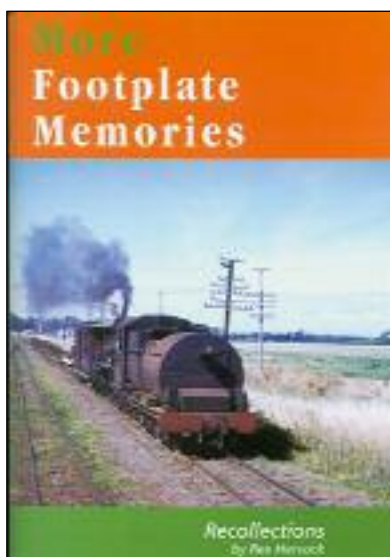


Cane Train

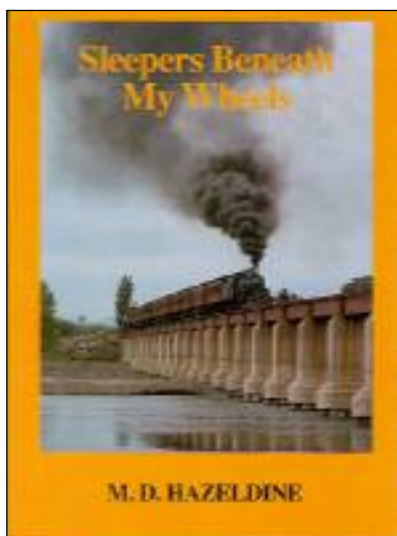


More Footplate Memories

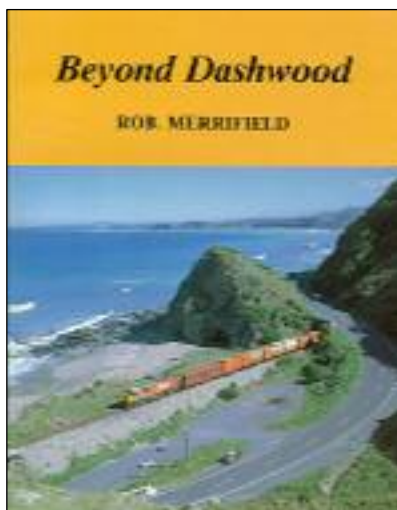


Sleepers Beneath My Wheels

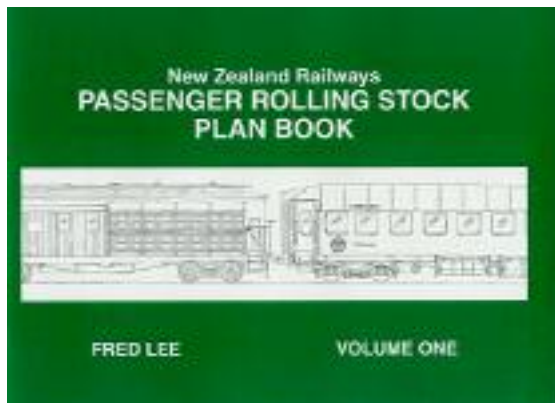


Beyond Dashwood

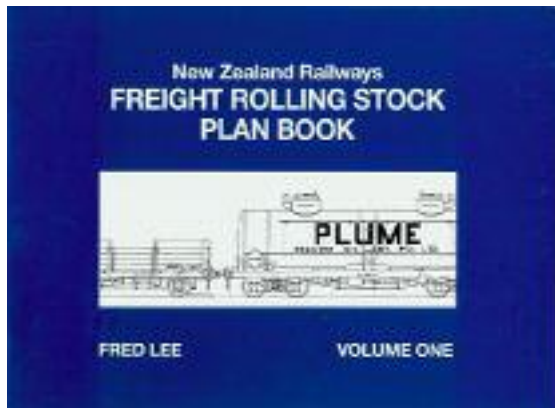


NZR Passenger Rolling Stock Plan Book. Volume 1.

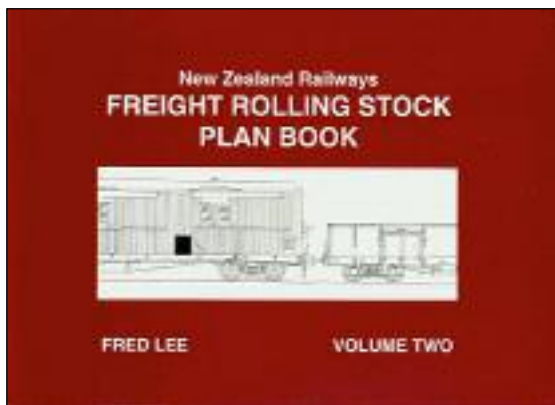

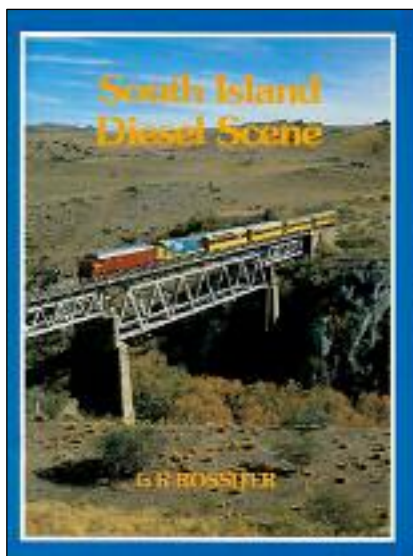

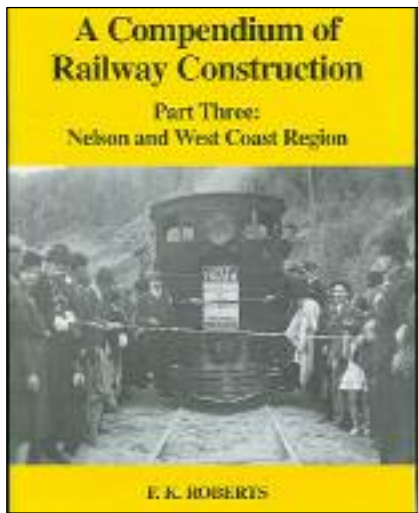

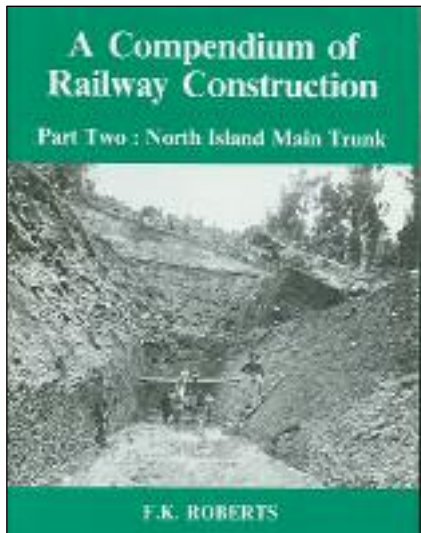

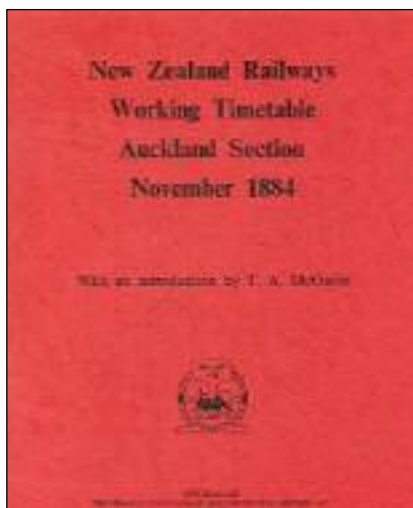

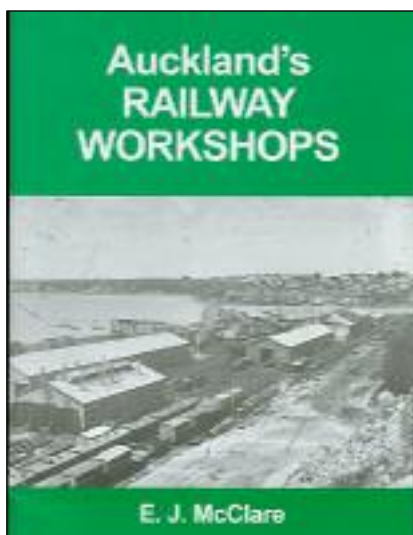

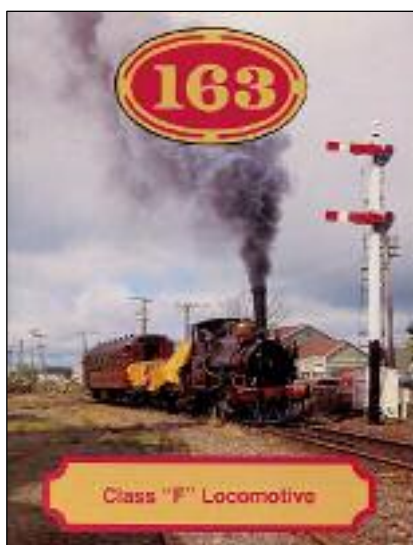


Auckland Railway Workshops 1875-1992

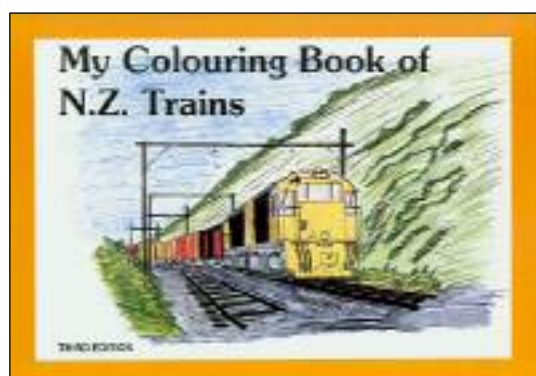

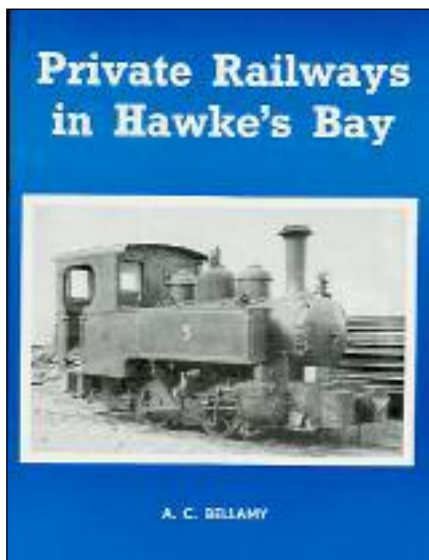

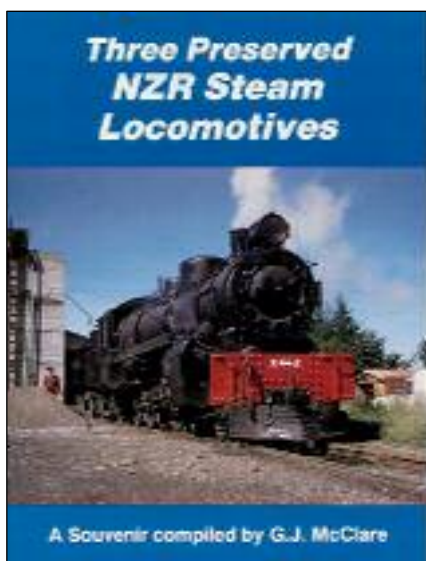

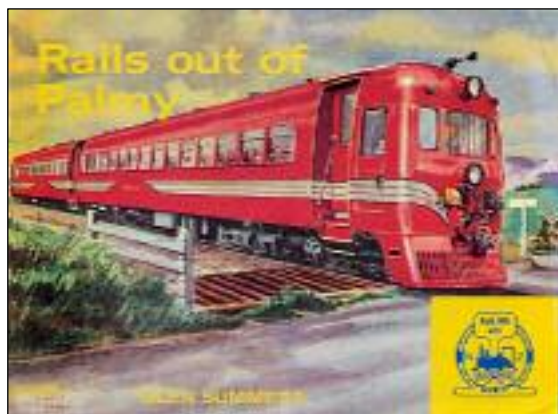


Three Preserved Steam Locomotives
